Unfortunately, we are unable to dispose of items that are not accepted by our trash hauler.

The following items are NOT ALLOWED:

No construction debris . Tires, Appliances, Liquid Waste, Industrial Waste, Chemical Products, Florescent Tubes, Oil, Oil Filters, Oil Rags, etc. Paint, Paint Thinners or Remover Cans, Herbicides and Pesticides, Radioactive Materials, Naturally Occurring (NORM), Diesel Fuel, Motor Oil, Lubricating Oil, Transmission Fluid, Kerosene, Lamp Oil, Brake Fluid, Cooking Grease, Railroad Ties (Call Office for Disposal info), Acrylic (Unless Dried Completely), Antifreeze, Auto Batteries, Cycle & Snowmobile Batteries, Engine Degreaser, Auto Body Filler, Paint in Liquid Form, Epoxy, Varnish, Turpentine, Mineral Spirits, Paint Stripper, Broken Smoke Detectors, Treated Fence Posts, Asbestos, Swimming Pool Acids, Ceramic Glazes, Artist Oils, Weed Killers, Refrigerators (Freon), Freezers (Freon), Microwaves and NO ELECTRONICS of any kind.

Tips on how to dispose of NOT ALLOWED items:

PAINTS & STAINS: Sherwin Williams and True Value in Gunnison both accept latex and oil based, Residential paints and stains.

<u>CAR BATTERIES & OIL:</u> Napa Auto Parts in Gunnison will accept used oil (no water or coolant mixed in) and old car batteries.

<u>ELECTRONICS</u>: The City of Gunnison accepts electronics once a month on the First Monday of the Month, 9 am to 4 pm. A fee of 75 cents per pound is charged. The remaining 2019 schedule is June 3-July 1-August 5-September 9-October 7 -November 4-December 2.
